Member Medical Officer Variable Special Pay Amount

Member Medical Officer Variable Special Pay Amount is the dollar amount paid to a medical officer for monthly variable special pay.

Permitted Values

NA

Structural Business Rules

A DoD Military Service member who is a member of the National Guard or Reserve must be paid a prorated amount for any period of active service less than one month.

A Member Medical Officer Variable Special Pay Amount must have an associated Member Medical Officer Variable Special Pay Stop Date when eligibility for monthly variable special pay ends.

A Member Medical Officer Variable Special Pay Amount must have an associated Member Medical Officer Variable Special Pay Start Date.

A dollar amount must have at least one numeric character followed by a decimal point and two numeric characters, or when the amount is less than one, a decimal point followed by two numeric characters.
