Member Survivor Benefit Plan Coverage Level Election

Member Survivor Benefit Plan Coverage Level Election is the coverage level an eligible DoD Military Service member elects for his/her Survivor Benefit Plan.

Permitted Values

- Elect coverage based on full gross pay
- Elect coverage based on my full gross pay under redux
- Elect coverage based on the threshold amount in effect on the date of retirement
- Elect coverage with a specified reduced base amount

Structural Business Rules

A DoD Military Service member may have only one Member Survivor Benefit Plan Coverage Level Election at a time.

Member Survivor Benefit Plan Coverage Type Election must be associated with a Member Survivor Benefit Plan Coverage Level Election, when the Standard Annuity participant's Member Survivor Benefit Plan Coverage Type Election is not Decline Election.

Member Survivor Benefit Plan Reduced Base Amount must be associated with Member Survivor Benefit Plan Coverage Level Election when the Member Survivor Benefit Plan Coverage Level Election is "Elect coverage with a specified reduced base amount".

A DoD Military Service member must designate only one Member Survivor Benefit Plan Reduced Base Amount when the Member Survivor Benefit Plan Coverage Level Election is "Elect coverage with a specified reduced base amount".
